**DIVING ON DIAMOND HARBOUR PIPELINE**

Please be advised that from Monday 26 April 2010 we will have commercial divers working on the Diamond Harbour pipelines.

Firstly the divers will be stabilising the existing pipe from damage caused by the tsunami and then they will be replacing sections of damaged pipe.

At different times there will be barges, boats and a collection of buoys placed along the pipeline.

Duration of work is expected to be 4-5 months

When divers are operating, the divers flag will be displayed which requires all powered craft to travel less than 5 knots within 200 metres of the area.
