

The diagram shows a situation on the start line which ends just after the starting signal at the start of a race.

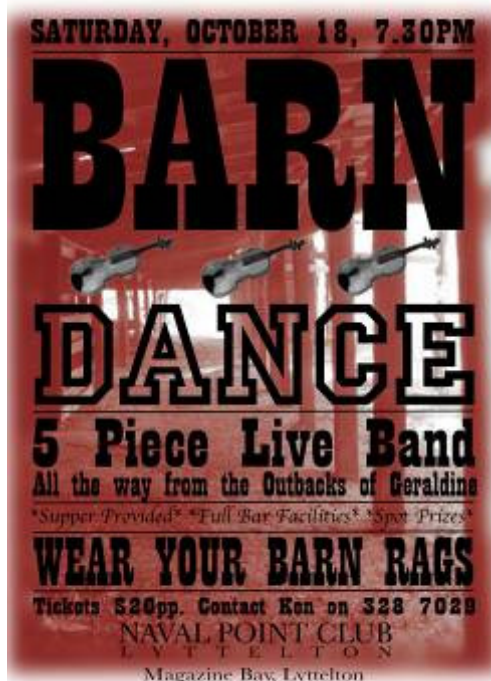
